House to Home



The project makes a house 'a home' for people who need a fresh start, and are already among the most vulnerable in our community. Habitat Ireland mobilises volunteers to deliver a dramatic impact, both physically and socially.

Connswater Housing Association was formed and registered in 1977, with an aim of regenerating the Connswater area of east Belfast. Following a period of growth and business success the Association relocated to Belfast city centre in 2013, and in 2022 rebranded to CONNSWATER, with homes with heart as a strapline.

Connswater continues to expand with housing developments throughout Belfast as well as Antrim, Lisburn, Larne,

Carrickfergus, Newtownabbey,

Newtownards, Portaferry and

Downpatrick.

In 2022, 10 Connswater employees successfully completed an OCN introduction to Community Restorative Justice (CRJ) practice, as part of Striving To Achieve a Restorative Society (STARS) project. Connswater was the first housing association to complete this training, which was funded through the Communities In Transition (CIT) fund.

Staff then went onto complete an introduction to Mediation, which included six steps, from an introduction to mediation, mapping of process, supervision and best practice in mediation. A further three employees have since completed a formal OCN level 3 qualification in Mediation. These employees participated in developing a Podcast with Alternatives NI based on the learning from the mediation training.

This has enabled Connswater to offer mediation as an early intervention in some lower level anti-social behaviour cases.


